Go East on Iris until you pass underneath Foothills Parkway and pass 47th St.

B.E.S. Is just past the intersection of 47th and Iris/Diagonal Highway on the South side of the road.

If you pass the Sinclair Gas Station on the North, you have gone too far.

From Longmont:

Proceed Boulder-bound on the Diagonal Highway.

When the road splits to Diagonal Hwy. and Foothills Pkwy., take the Diagonal exit.

Turn Left at the Stoplight (Iris. Ave.)

B.E.S. will be just after the next stoplight (47th St.) on your right.
